Last week we talked about how the live-webcam stream was part of our calling to proclaim Christ, but evangelism isn't just about showing what we do, isn't just about talking to people about Jesus and how He can change their lives - it's also about how we show the great love

that we receive in Jesus each week to everyone around us.

What does that mean?

It means that we are open as much as we possibly can be - that people can wander by and hear a hymn and be called into the church building to meet Jesus.

It means that our front door is welcoming and open wide rather than locked shut. It means our garden is kept tidy!

It means that we are available to community groups who want to use the church building and it means that we are an active part of the parish; that we are represented on the various committees



and groups around Hayes Town.

It means that if anyone needs us we are easy to get hold of it.

It means that at all times and in all things people understand that we are there for them - in all things - and through that love and availability people will come to know the love of Jesus Christ.
