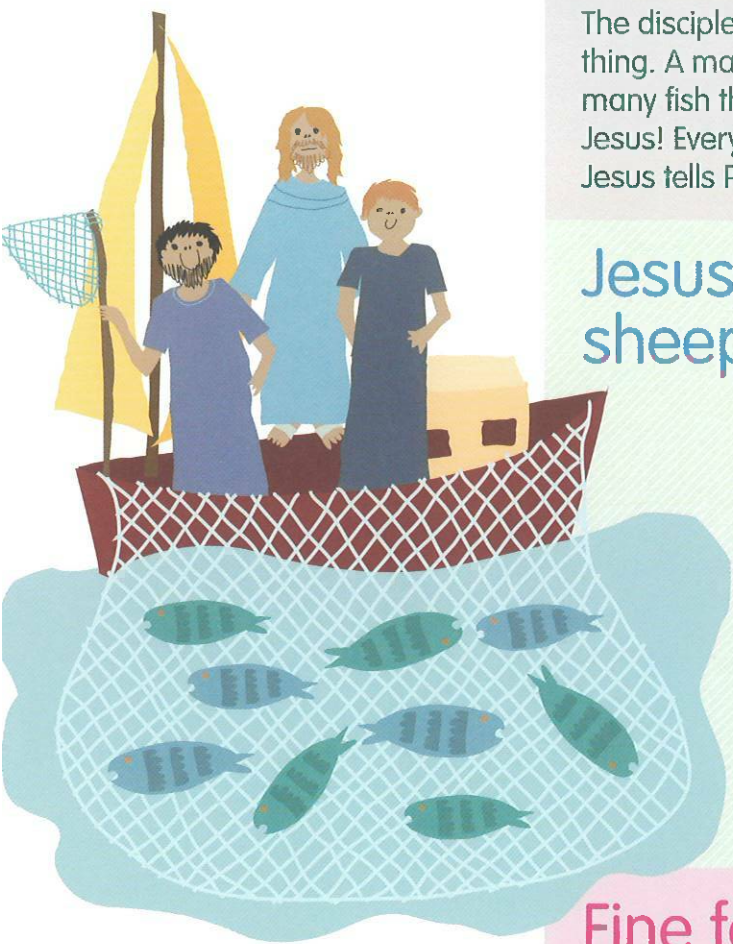


# LOOK

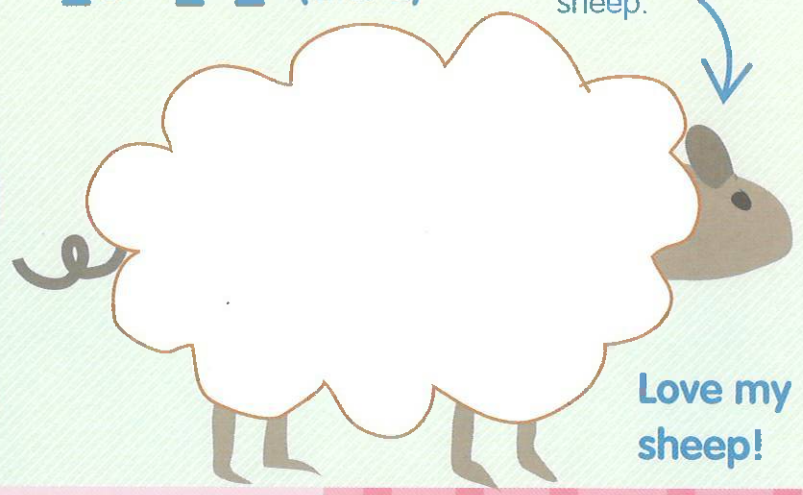


### Jesus' sheep

Jesus cooked fish for the disciples.



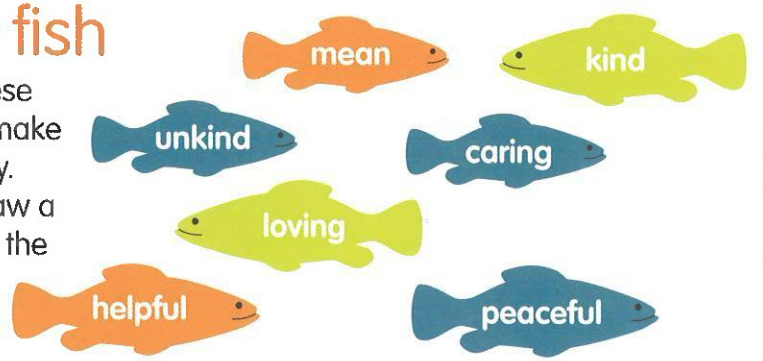
Draw your favourite meal on the plate.
