

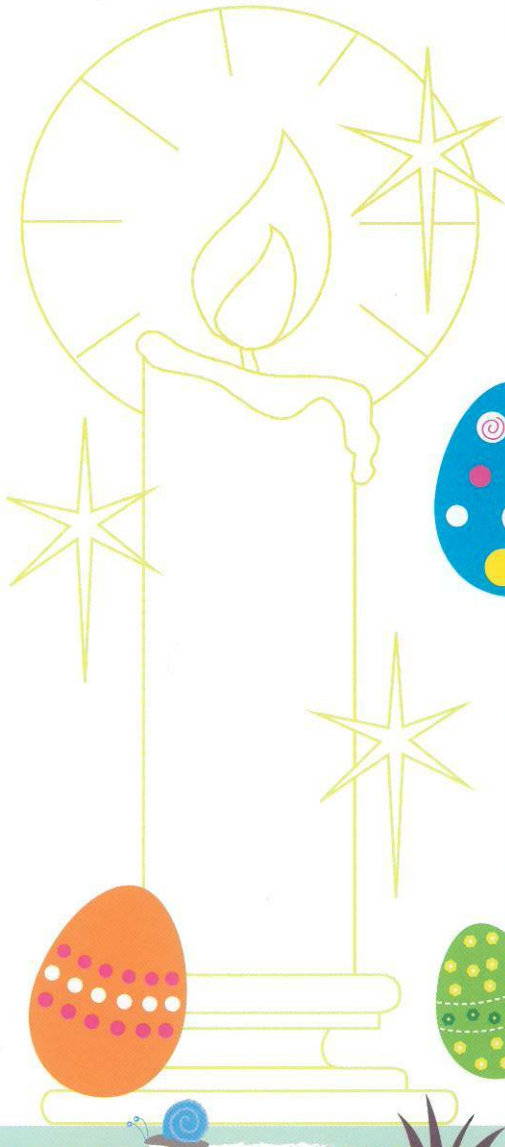

one you see in church.



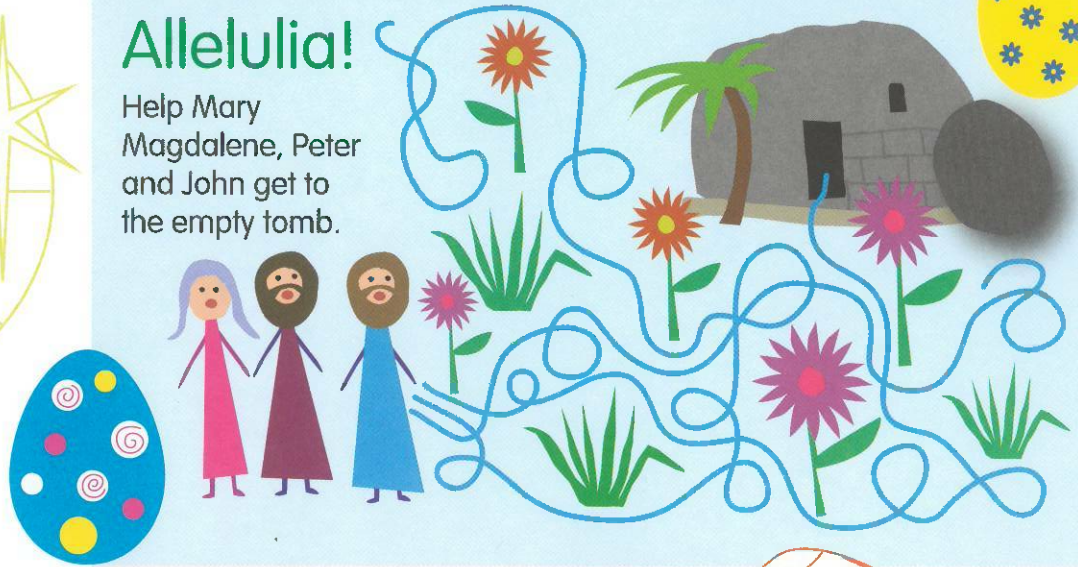
## A PRAYER TO SAY

the empty tomb.



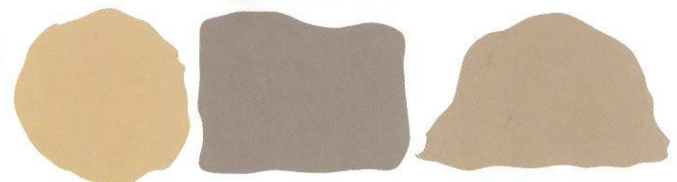
## Easter Eggs
